New Mexico Tech Ranked Among the Nation's Elite

With the beginning of each fall semester comes a new set of annual rankings for America's colleges. As has become an annual custom, New Mexico Tech resides among the nation's elite universities, ranked either atop or near the top of a number of this year's lists.

The 2018 rankings from Payscale.com and College Factual's annual national college rankings place New Mexico Tech not only No. 1 among New Mexico's public four-year colleges by a wide margin, but also among the nation's elite institutions as well.

For the second year in a row, College Factual ranked New Mexico Tech No. 1 nationwide among all universities in Engineering and Physics when it comes to the best colleges for the money or best value. Payscale ranks NMT No. 9 among nearly 1,000 public universities nationally on return on investment by annual percentage. That ranking jumps to No. 6 for students who live off campus. U.S. New and World Report ranked New Mexico Tech the No. 3 public university on its West Regional Schools list and No. 23 overall among all universities.
