


We be taking this trip for the purpose of touring a bridge which will be undergoing construction by the New Mexico Department of Transportation and is therefore an excellent opportunity for our club members to see civil engineering at work in the real world. This trip will take place from 8am on Friday, September 27th, and last until Saturday, September 28th.
