

To the Senate of the New Mexico Tech SGA,

We, the undergraduate students working in the Cytonuclear Lab at New Mexico Tech under the direction of Dr. Joel Sharbrough (Asst. Prof. Biology), are requesting financial assistance from the Student Government Association so that we may attend the *Evolution* 2022 conference in Cleveland, Ohio, this summer, June 24-28.

Research in our lab is focused on sub-cellular interactions between genes in the nucleus, and genes in other parts of the cell, such as chloroplasts and mitochondria.

Although relatively new to Tech, our research mentor, Dr. Sharbrough, has already published papers from his lab here in Socorro. Dr. Sharbrough has attended the Evolution conference for several years now, and he believes the upcoming event provides a relaxed and encouraging atmosphere that is perfect for rising scientists to share their science and get feedback from the community.
