The American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE) branch at New Mexico Tech would like to receive funding for the travel, hotel and registration fees to have members attend the National Conference in Phoenix, Arizona. The students would leave for Arizona on Friday Nov. 11th, 2022 and return on Monday Nov. 14th, 2022. The club is wanting to sponsor twenty (20) members who are interested in attending the conference. Those members were asked to submit cover letters and each of those has been included with this request form. Many of the members are planning their undergraduate research at this conference.

A hotel was found and booked in Tempe, Arizona in which there are 5 rooms. Each room contains two double beds and each double bed will sleep two members (4 people per room). The hotel found was the Marriott at 2000 W Westcourt Way, Tempe, Arizona. The rooms were gotten at a discounted rate in which all rooms for all three nights will total out to be \$2200 (including tax). This was the cheapest option to house the twenty members who plan to attend the National Conference.

To get to Arizona, two NMT vehicles will need to be rented. The facilities management form says that the vans can be rented for \$0.60/mile including gas. As the trip is 380 miles each way, that brings the travel cost to \$456. Another \$50 would be needed to cover the transportation between the convention center, restaurants and the hotel. Thus, the total transportation cost would be \$500. There are two drivers lined up who are certified through the university to drive the NMT vehicles.

The last part of the cost would be for registration fees. Each student must register to present at the National Conference. The "early bird" fee is \$150 for each member, if they register by October 2nd. The registration cost will increase after October 2nd. AIChE is requesting assistance covering half of the registration costs (20 students at \$75 per student). The club is planning on having the members pay for the remaining \$75 for their individual registration. The registration cost would come out to be **\$1500**.

In total, the requested assistance is \$4200.

All receipts would be kept and returned to the SGA upon return from the National Conference. All food will be paid for by the members themselves when in Arizona. The club is also working to plan fundraising events so the club can save funds for the upcoming conference. Detailed below is the itemized budget:
