


Title IX & NMT Sexual Misconduct Grievance Procedures

Initial Steps & Informal Resolution Flow Chart



Tech must respond to a report when the Institution has knowledge of sexual harassment/discrimination in an educational program or activity in the U.S.

Report vs. Formal Complaint

- Report
 - ◆ Initiates obligation to respond, including offering supportive measures
 - ◆ Complainant's identity may be kept confidential from Respondent at this stage
- Formal Complaint
 - ◆ Officially initiates grievance process
 - ◆ Cannot be filed anonymously

Educational Program or Activity

- Building owned/controlled by student organization
- Under institution's disciplinary authority
- Obligation to respond even when some conduct alleged to be contributing to the hostile environment occurred outside of the education program or activity


How We Must Respond

- Take action to promptly and effectively
 - ◆ End any sexual harassment/discrimination in institution's program or activity
 - ◆ Prevent its recurrence and
 - ◆ Remedy its effects
- Follow grievance procedure outlined in current Title IX regulations
